2012 report

- 2009 SDAC is the latest available source for data about the labour force participation rate of people with disability.
- 2009 SDAC does not provide this data for the Indigenous population, therefore Indigenous data needs to be taken from a different source (e.g. NATSISS 2008).
- The NATSISS uses an abbreviated form of the Disability Module, which is less detailed than the SDAC.
- 'Not disabled' is a category in the 'Disability status' variable, so data comparable the disabled and non-disabled populations are available in the disaggregation's listed above.
