

barriers to work; a reduced work capacity, or does not have participation requirements and is volunteering for employment services assistance.

CODE JCA Job Capacity Assessment

A Job Capacity Assessment is used to help determine medical eligibility for Disability Support Pension. It determines the impact of medical conditions or disability on an individual's ability to work and any benefit of employment

assistance.
