The scope excludes: • all care to admitted patients, including same day admitted patient care delivered by ambulatory mental health care service units • 'in-reach' mental health service contacts, that is, service contacts provided to patients admitted to admitted patient mental health care services or residential mental health services • support services that are not specialised mental health care services (see Specialised mental health service) and services provided by non-government organisations. Excluded from the CMHC NMDS scope is all activity reported to: • the Admitted patient care NMDS • the Residential mental health care NMDS.
