The three main valid relationships and their associated meaning are listed in the table below.

Relationship Type	Complementary Relationship	Description
Supersedes	Has been superseded by	An indicator of a superseded item and the item that it was superseded by.
Is formed using	Is used in the formation of	An indicator of an item that is used in the calculation of, or is a component of, another item.
See also	See also	An indicator of an associated item, irrespective of the nature of the association.
