The number of previous pregnancies is an important component of the woman's reproductive history. Parity may be a risk factor for adverse maternal and perinatal

outcomes.

## Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use: In multiple pregnancies with more than one type of outcome, the pregnancies

should be recorded in the following order:

all live births

stillbirth

spontaneous abortioninduced abortion

ectopic pregnancy

A pregnancy resulting in multiple births should be counted as one pregnancy.

Where the outcome was one stillbirth and one live birth, count as stillbirth.

If a previous pregnancy was a hydatidiform mole, code as spontaneous or induced

abortion (or rarely, ectopic pregnancy), depending on the outcome.
