### Collection and usage attributes

<b>Collection methods:</b>	This triage classification is to be used in the emergency departments of hospitals. Patients will be triaged into one of five categories on the National Triage Scale according to the triageur's response to the question: 'This patient should wait for medical care no longer than ...?'.
	The triage category is allocated by an experienced <a href="#">registered nurse</a> or medical practitioner. If the triage category changes, record the more urgent category.
