is not feasible in some data collections and alternative questions are:

• What was [your] [the person's] age last birthday?

• What is [your] [the person's] age in complete years?

Comments: In most community services data collections, age in years is often reported rather

than derived from the metadata item <u>Person—date of birth, DDMMYYYY</u>. However, <u>Person—date of birth, DDMMYYYY</u> is the preferred method for

collection of age data.
