Guide for use:	<p>CODE 01 No intervention</p> <p>Refers to no intervention taken with regard to the behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose.</p> <p>CODE 02 Information and education (not including written regimen)</p> <p>Refers to where there is no treatment provided to the patient for a behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose other than information and education.</p> <p>CODE 03 Counselling</p> <p>Refers to any method of individual or group counselling directed towards the behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose. This code excludes counselling activities that are part of referral options as defined in code 05 and 06.</p> <p>CODE 04 Pharmacotherapy</p> <p>Refers to pharmacotherapies that are prescribed or recommended for the management of the behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose.</p> <p>CODE 05 Referral provided to a health professional</p> <p>Refers to a referral to a health professional who has the expertise to assist the patient manage the behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose.</p> <p>CODE 06 Referral to a community program, support group or service</p> <p>Refers to a referral to community program, support group or service that has the expertise and resources to assist the patient manage the behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose.</p> <p>CODE 07 Written regimen provided</p> <p>Refers to the provision of a written regimen (nutrition plan, exercise prescription, smoking contract) given to the patient to assist them with the management of the behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose.</p> <p>CODE 08 Surgery</p> <p>Refers to a surgical procedure undertaken to assist the patient with the management of the behaviour-related risk factor intervention-purpose.</p>
