## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Guide for use:</b>	Where more than one telephone number has been recorded, then each telephone number should have the appropriate telephone number type code assigned.
<b>Comments:</b>	Concerned with the use of person identification data. For organisations that create, use or maintain records on people. Organisations should use this standard, where appropriate, for collecting data when registering people. The positive and unique identification of people is a critical event in service delivery, with direct implications for the safety and quality of care delivered by health and community services.
