	This code includes any structures that people actually live in regardless of its intended purpose. The structure may or may not be tenatable.
	CODE 2   Vacant
	A vacant structure is only a dwelling if it is intended for human residence. The structure may or may not be tenatable.
	Thus a shed, garage, office, etc. is counted as an occupied dwelling if people are living there, but is not counted as vacant if there are no residents as the purpose of the structure is not for human habitation.
