Guide For Use: It is possible for a household to be counted in more than one special needs category.

1. Indigenous: where one or more household members (including children) identify as Indigenous (see data elements? Indigenous status? and? Indigenous household?).

2. Newly arrived refugees: people born overseas who have arrived in Australia within the last two years and are recognised as refugees.

3 People with a disability: where one or more household

member/s (including children) have any activity limitation due to an impairment and/or disability. For example, difficulty in performing such tasks and activities as seeing, hearing and recognising things; movement activities; daily life activities; interpersonal behaviours; communication activities and learning; and applying knowledge and performing tasks. The definition is based around the WHO 1980 activity classification (see data concept ?Disability?, and data elements ?Support type? and ?Support required?).

4. Youth: people aged 15?24 inclusive;

5. Frail Aged: older persons (indicative age 70 years and over) who have been assessed as being moderately to severely incapacitated in personal care and/or other activities of daily living due to their age or long term health condition; and 6. People with Drug and Alcohol problems: people whose pattern of substance use is such that it is causing damage to health either physically and/or mentally (i.e. harmful use).
