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Some metadata items provide you the option of selecting to open/save in long form or short form. They are as follows:

- Data element – The long-form includes selected attributes from its data element concept and value domain
- Data element concept – The long-form includes selected attributes from its object class and property
- Value domain – The long-form includes selected attributes from its classification scheme (if it has one)
- Data set specification – The long-form includes its data elements
