Definition: A person, generally aged 0 - 12 years, who uses a child care or preschool service.
Context: Information about the number and characteristics of children using child care and preschool services assists in the analyses of patterns of utilisation.

Children included in the CS NMDS collection are those that attend an outlet during the reference week. If a child who usually attends the outlet is absent during the reference week and their place has not been filled by another child, then the absent child's details should be reported in the CS NMDS. If the absent child's place has been filled by another child then the child who actually attends during the reference week should be included in the CS NMDS collection.
