## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>Each surgical treatment procedure used in the initial treatment of the cancer should be recorded. Surgical procedures performed for palliative purposes only should not be included.</p> <p>For surgical procedures involved in the administration of another modality (eg., implantation of infusion pump, isolated limb perfusion/infusion, intra-operative radiotherapy) record both the surgery and the other modality.</p> <p>Any systemic treatment which can be coded as a procedure through ICD-10-AM should be so coded (eg., stem cell or bone marrow infusion).</p> <p>The Australian Classification of Health Interventions (ACHI), which is a part of ICD-10-AM, can be used to classify procedures.</p>
