<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>CODE 1.0 Complete response</p> <p>Complete disappearance of all measurable disease, including tumour markers, for at least four weeks. No new lesions or new evidence of disease.</p> <p>CODE 2.1 Partial response</p> <p>A decrease by at least 50% of the sum of the products of the maximum diameter and perpendicular diameter of all measurable lesions, for at least four weeks. No new lesions or worsening of disease.</p> <p>CODE 2.2 Stable or static disease</p> <p>No change in measurable lesions qualifying as partial response or progression and no evidence of new lesions.</p> <p>CODE 2.3 Progressive disease</p> <p>An increase by at least 25% of the sum of the products of the maximum diameter and a perpendicular diameter of any measurable lesion, or the appearance of new lesions.</p>
