Context:	<p>Community housing, along with public rental housing, is part of the social housing sector and provides housing assistance on a basis which is respectful of tenants rights, including opportunities for participatory management, and constructive of links with community development.</p> <p>Community housing can cover short, medium and long-term tenancies.</p> <p>Community housing providers manage the provision of housing assistance and as such are the main source of information about the tenants in the community housing sector.</p> <p>Community housing providers may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• housing cooperatives• housing associations• other community service organisations
