# Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use: CODE 2 Medical practitioner - general practitioner, and

CODE 3 Medical practitioner - specialist

For the two codes listed above referrals made by medical practitioners on behalf of community-based palliative care agencies, inpatient facilities and residential aged care services should be recorded as a referral from that particular agency/service/organisation and not as a referral from the medical practitioner.

CODE 4 Community-based palliative care agency

Excludes hospices.

CODE 5 Community-based service - other

Includes referrals from other community-based health services, consumer groups and patient advocacy/support groups, e.g. Motor Neurone Disease Association. Excludes hospices.

CODE 6 Inpatient facility

Includes designated and non-designated palliative care units in hospitals and hospices.

CODE 8 Other source

Includes outpatient departments at hospices and hospitals and emergency departments.
