Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use:	CODE 1 Yes—if this is the first care and protection order the child has ever been on in his/her life. CODE 2 No – child has been on an order in the past 5 years in this jurisdiction. CODE 3 No – child has been on an order in the past 5 years in another jurisdiction
Collection methods:	Where it is not possible to determine if a child has been on an order in another jurisdiction in the past 5 years, the child should be placed in category 1.
