For each of the following evaluated clinical states, code Y if the comorbidity exists or code N if the comorbidity does not exist.

- AIDS
- · hepatic failure
- lymphoma
- metastatic cancer
- leukaemia-myeloma
- immunosuppressed
- cirrhosis

Code	Code represents
YNNNNN	AIDS comorbidity exists. Hepatic failure, lymphoma, metastatic cancer, leukaemia-myeloma, immunosuppressed and cirrhosis do not exist.
NYNYNNN	Hepatic failure and metastatic co-morbidities exist. AIDS, lymphoma, leukaemia-myeloma, immunosuppressed and cirrhosis do not exist.
