Duration of service for a particular service type is calculated by subtracting *Service* commencement date from *Last service date*. Or, for service users who have ceased to receive services during a reporting period, *Service commencement* 

date should be subtracted from Service exit date.

For service users who received services on only one day during the reporting period (and whose *Service commencement date* and *Last service date* are reported as the same date), the duration of service should be calculated as '1'.
