## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>This data item should be recorded for all children who were the subject of a contact during the year.</p> <p>CODE 1 Yes - Currently in out-of-home care</p> <p>The child is currently on a care and protection order in the jurisdiction</p> <p>CODE 2 Yes - Past history of placement in out-of-home care</p> <p>The child has previously been on a care and protection order but it is not in effect currently</p> <p>CODE 3 No</p> <p>The child is not currently or previously been on a care and protection order.</p>

## Collection and usage attributes

**Collection methods:** This should be recorded at time of the contact. It only refers to care and protection orders the child is on at the time of the contact, or if the child was on a care and protection order previously in his/her life.
