These are primarily aimed at children in the year or two before they commence full-time schooling.</p> <p>The terms most commonly used to describe preschool services in various states and territories are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Kindergarten—Tasmania, WA and Queensland (In Queensland between 2003–07 Kindergarten is being replaced with a year called Preschool);• Kindergarten or Preschool—Victoria;• Preschool (including Child Parent Centres)—SA;• Preschool— NSW, ACT and NT.
