## Collection and usage attributes

#### Guide for use:

<u>Code 1 General Practitioners</u> are medical practitioners that have membership with the Royal Australian College of General Practice or who hold a training position supervised by a member of the college. It also includes those who are currently:

- · Vocationally registered
- RACGP fellowship
- RACGP fellowship trainee
- A GP register

<u>Code 2 Hospital non-specialist (salaried)</u> is a medical practitioner mainly employed in a salaried position in a hospital who does not have a recognised specialist qualification and who is not in training to gain a recognised specialist qualification. They include interns, resident Medical Officers (RMOs), and Hospital Medical Officers (HMOs).

<u>Code 3 Specialist</u> is a medical practitioner with a qualification awarded by, or which equates to that awarded by, the relevant specialist professional college in Australia.

<u>Code 4 Specialist-in-training</u> is a medical practitioner who has been accepted by a specialist medical college into a training position supervised by a member of the college.

<u>Code 5 Other clinicians</u> include all medical practitioners that have undertaken clinical work in the week prior to registration but who do not fall into any of the above categories

<u>Code 6 Non-clinicians</u> includes all medical practitioners that have not undertaken clinical work in the week prior to registration
