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Denominator items - Indicator

A set of items used to calculate the denominator. The denominator items include the Data element/Data set (or a description of the data element if one has not been attached), data source, NMDS/DSS and the collection methods/guide for use.

- The *denominator data element* is a set of data elements used to calculate denominator. Wherein a data element has not been attached the user can include a description of the intended data element in the field labelled *data element description if no data element attached*.
- The *data source* is a specific data set, database and reference from where data are sourced.
- The *NMDS/DSS* is the name of the National minimum data set or data set specifications from which the data element is sourced.
- The *collection methods/guide for use* includes information such as the methods of data collection including census, sample survey, and administrative by-product.
- The *denominator data element/s*, *data source* and/or *NMDS/DSS* attached to the Indicator must relate to the appropriate year/s of data collection.
