Computation description:	Numerator is restricted to overnight admissions, i.e. where the date of admission and date of separation are different. Care types in numerator: rehabilitation, palliative care, geriatric evaluation and management, psychogeriatric care, and maintenance care. Rates are directly age-standardised to the Australian population as at 30 June 2001. Presented per 1,000 population.
Computation:	$1,000 \times (\text{Numerator} \div \text{Denominator})$ Calculated separately for each care type.

Interpretation of rates for jurisdictions should take into consideration variation in the assignment of care types and cross-border flows.

The quality of data on Indigenous status is not considered to be adequate for analysis purposes for the ACT and Tasmania.
