physiotherapy, psychology, chiropractic) will be used. From 2012, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health practitioners, Chinese medicine practitioners and

medical radiation practitioners will also be included in the Scheme.

Questionnaires to collect workforce information as part of the National Registration and Accreditation Scheme will need to be designed carefully to ensure sufficient

Indigenous status responses are collected.

Other issues caveats: Specification: Interim

Scheme, the only available data will be for medical practitioners and

nurses/midwives.
