Other issues caveats: It would be useful to further standardise some of the public health expenditure categories such as 'selected health promotion', and collect information on public health activities conducted by non-health government departments.
The data quality statement should reflect that additional work to capture all public expenditure (through avenues other than health-based), should be undertaken.
