**Other issues caveats:** While the Labour Market Assistance Outcomes Report presents outcomes on Indigenous job seekers across each employment service delivered by DEEWR, for this measure a single figure will be presented. It will be the number of Indigenous job seekers in employment three months after participating in employment services divided by the number of Indigenous job seekers who have received employment assistance over the previous 12 months. This will allow the data to be compared over time even though there are changes in the delivery of employment services from Job Network to Job Services Australia, the reformed Indigenous Employment Program and the future implementation of Disability Employment Services reforms.
