

## Collection and usage attributes

#### Guide for use:

CODE 1 Children

This code is used to indicate a population of children under 12 years old.

CODE 2 Young people

This code is used to indicate a population aged between 12 and 25 years, who do not have dependent children aged 25 years or less.

CODE 3 Single Men

This code is used to indicate a population aged between 26 and 49 years, and who do not have dependent children.

CODE 4 Single Women

This code is used to indicate a population aged between 26 and 49 years, and who do not have dependent children.

CODE 5 Families with children

This code is used to indicate a population who regard themselves as a family and have dependent children, aged 25 years of less. A family is defined as a group of two or more persons who usually live in the same household and who are related to each other by blood, marriage or adoption.

CODE 6 Families without children

This code is used to indicate a population who regard themselves as a family and do not have dependent children, aged 25 years of less. A family is defined as a group of two or more persons who usually live in the same household and who are related to each other by blood, marriage or adoption.

CODE 7 Older people

This code is used to indicate a population aged 50 years or more without dependent children aged 25 years or less .

CODE 8 Other

This code is used to indicate that none of the other categories of the value domain are specified for attention.
