<b>Computation description:</b>	<p>Categories of self-assessed health status are excellent, very good, good, fair and poor. These should be combined into two categories for reporting: excellent/very good/good and fair/poor.</p> <p>For the service type admitted hospitalisations, access is recorded based on the last 12 months. For all other services access is recorded based on the last 2 weeks.</p> <p>Rates are directly age-standardised.</p> <p>Limited to people aged 15 years or over.</p> <p>The service types to be reported are admitted hospitalisations; casualty/ outpatients; GP and/ or specialist doctor consultations; consultations with other health professional; dental consultation.</p> <p>Analysis by remoteness and SEIFA Index of Relative Socioeconomic Disadvantage (IRSD) is based on usual residence of person.</p> <p>Presented as a percentage; 95% confidence intervals and relative standard errors are calculated for rates.</p>					
<b>Computation:</b>	<p><math>100 \times (\text{Numerator} \div \text{Denominator})</math></p> <p>Calculated separately for each type of service and by categories of self-assessed health status.</p>					
<b>Numerator:</b>	Number of people aged 15 years and over who accessed particular health services in the past 12 months (for hospital admissions) or 2 weeks (for other health services)
