<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>The International Federation of Gynecology and Obstetrics (FIGO) endometrial cancer stage according to 2009 definitions.</p> <p><b>Stage I:</b> tumour confined to the corpus uteri.</p> <p>CODE 1 Stage IA</p> <p>No invasion or less than half myometrial invasion.</p> <p>CODE 2 Stage IB</p> <p>Invasion equal to or greater than half of the myometrium.</p> <p><b>Stage II</b></p> <p>CODE 3 Stage II</p> <p>Tumour invades cervical stroma, but does not extend beyond the uterus.</p> <p>Note: In situ involvement of the endocervix that does not invade the stroma is not a Stage II lesion.</p> <p><b>Stage III:</b> local and/or regional spread of the tumour.</p> <p>CODE 4 Stage IIIA</p> <p>Tumour invades the serosa of the corpus uteri and/or the adnexa.</p> <p>CODE 5 Stage IIIB</p> <p>Involvement of the vagina, parametrium and/or the pelvic peritoneum.</p> <p><b>Stage IIIC:</b> retroperitoneal node involvement</p> <p>CODE 6 Stage IIIC1</p> <p>Pelvic node involvement.</p> <p>CODE 7 Stage IIIC2</p> <p>Paraaortic involvement.</p> <p><b>Stage IV:</b> tumour invades bladder and/or bowel mucosa, and/or distant metastases.</p> <p>CODE 8 Stage IVA</p> <p>Tumour invasion of bladder and/or bowel mucosa.</p> <p>CODE 9 Stage IVB</p> <p>Distant metastases, including intra-abdominal metastases and/or inguinal lymph nodes.</p>
