Definition:	<p>The basis of diagnostic investigation at the time of first presentation.</p> <p>This relates to whether the patient was symptomatic at the time of first presentation, and if not, what first initiated the process of investigations leading to diagnosis.</p> <p>A symptom is any morbid phenomenon or departure from the normal in structure, function or sensation experienced by the patient and indicative of disease.</p>
