- it only captures homeless people (or those at risk of homelessness) who have applied for social housing and have been allocated
- that being allocated to social housing is by definition assistance to secure and sustain tenure with no requirement for length of tenure

Greatest need is used as a proxy for homelessness or risk of homelessness. Households in 'greatest need' are those at the time of allocation were subject to one or more of the following circumstances:

- they were homeless
- their life or safety was at risk in their accommodation
- their health condition was aggravated by their housing
- their housing was inappropriate to their needs
- they had very high rental costs
