Any act by a person having the care of the child which exposes a child to, or involves a child in, sexual processes beyond his or her understanding or contrary to

accepted community standards.

CODE 3 Emotional abuse

Any act by a person having the care of a child that results in the child suffering any

kind of significant emotional deprivation or trauma.

CODE 4 Neglect

Any serious omissions or commissions by a person having the care of a child which, within the bounds of cultural tradition, constitute a failure to provide

conditions which are essential for the healthy, physical and emotional development

of a child.

Comments: These categories may be used in different ways by different jurisdictions,

depending on the state or territories' own definitions, policies and practices. In addition, a child subject to abuse and neglect may be subject to more than one type of abuse and neglect (for example, sexual abuse is often also associated with

emotional abuse).
