	<p>CODE 1 Educational support</p> <p>Information about the disease, treatment and outcomes given to the patient. This may be through physical or electronic methods.</p> <p>CODE 2 Community service</p> <p>Support services provided by volunteers or community groups without specific professional training.</p> <p>CODE 3 Psychiatrist</p> <p>Assessment, treatment and/or consultation with a trained psychiatrist or psychiatry registrar.</p> <p>CODE 4 Psychologist</p> <p>Assessment, treatment and/or consultation with a registered psychologist or provisional psychologist.</p> <p>CODE 5 Specialist nurse/nurse counsellor</p> <p>Assessment, treatment and/or consultation with a nurse with specific training in counselling or specialist training in the disease/disorder area.</p> <p>CODE 6 Professional or volunteer support group</p> <p>Involvement in a professional or volunteer support group that relates to the disease/disorder or the associated effect of the disease/disorder.</p> <p>CODE 7 Individual peer support</p> <p>Contact with another individual who has had or currently has the same or similar disease/disorder, expressly for the purpose of being with provided with support in regards to their disease/disorder. This may be in person or over the telephone.</p> <p>CODE 8 Counsellor/bereavement counsellor</p> <p>The patient has been treated by a counsellor or bereavement counsellor in regards to their current disease/disorder.</p> <p>CODE 9 Pastoral care</p> <p>Care given by chaplains, clergy or spiritual advisors from any religion.</p>

Guide for use:	<p>Record the specialist support services used by a patient as part of their care during the initial round of treatment for cancer.</p> <p>This data element should be recorded multiple times when multiple services have been used.</p>
Collection methods:	This information should be sought from the patient's medical record or collected in multi-disciplinary team meetings.
Comments:	This information is used to evaluate the quality of care for patients with cancer, and may have implications for access to, and the provision of, cancer services.
