The NATSISS uses the abbreviated form of the Disability Module, which is less

detailed than the SDAC.

Social and community activities as defined in the NATSISS are more culturally

appropriate for Indigenous Australians than those in the SDAC.

Comparison data for the non-disabled population is only available for the first of these performance indicators, from the General Social Survey 2006, and then only

for adults.
