Definition: Staffed residential services are those that provide overnight accommodation in a

domestic-style environment, which is staffed for a minimum of 6 hours a day and at least 50 hours per week. Accommodation may be provided on a short, medium or

long term basis.

Context: Mental health non-government organisation establishments service type taxonomy.

Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use: Distinguishing features:

- Deliver services in a setting that provides overnight accommodation to consumers
- Domestic-style environment
- Consumers are encouraged to take responsibility for their daily living activities
- Staff are on-site for a minimum of 6 hours a day and at least 50 hours per week

Inclusions:

- · Residential rehabilitation
- · Residential respite
- · Crisis residential services
- Transitional residential services
- Step-up step-down services

Exclusions:

- Facilities that are visited via in-reach services provided by NGO staff but where the residence is not regarded as NGO worker's place of employment
- Clinically-staffed residential services

Example services:

- St Bartholomew's House
- Burnside HASP
