

Full time equivalent (FTE) employed health practitioner rates calculated from the National Health Workforce Data Set will be available on a national basis for 2011 and subsequent years.

For medical practitioners, nurses and midwives and dental practitioners, 10-year age groups will be needed to support the disaggregation by state and territory. Age groups are: under 25, 25-34, 35-44, 45-54, 55-64 and 65 or over.

Status of the calculation of fulltime equivalent employed health practitioner rate for professions is:

- Medical practitioner workforce: Data for 2010 is available but does not include Queensland and Western Australia. Data for 2011 will be available for all states and territories.
- 2. Nursing and midwifery workforce: Data for 2011 is available, however Western Australia data is incomplete.
- 3. Dental workforce: Data for 2011 is available.
