DoHA Indigenous population projections were prepared from ABS Indigenous Experimental 2006 Estimated Resident Population (ERP) data (at SLA level) projected forward so as to align with published *ABS Indigenous Experimental Estimates and Projections* (ABS cat. no. 3238.0, series B) at the state and national level.

DoHA projections by remoteness areas are prepared by summing SLA projections to Remoteness Areas.
