	CODE 1 Neo-adjuvant
	This code should be recorded when androgen deprivation therapy (ADT) is used prior to the main treatment.
	CODE 2 Adjuvant
	This code should be recorded when androgen deprivation therapy (ADT) is used after the main treatment.
	CODE 3 Salvage
	This code should be recorded when androgen deprivation therapy (ADT) is used after a recurrence of prostate cancer for a patient who has had a radical prostatectomy.
	CODE 4 Palliative
	This code should be recorded when androgen deprivation therapy (ADT) is used to manage and alleviate symptoms and control tumour growth in palliative patients.
	CODE 9 Unknown
	This code should be recorded when androgen deprivation therapy (ADT) has been used in the treatment of a patient but the purpose of the therapy is not ascertainable from the data source.
