**Computation:** Calculated by direct estimation of life expectancy for all Australians, Indigenous and

non-Indigenous Australians using the average number of deaths in the 3-year period and the estimated resident population at the mid-point of that period.

born if they experienced mortality rates at each age that are currently experienced

by the relevant population.
