Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use: This value domain is dependent upon the type of professional group the individual belongs and the endorsement type indicated. For example, an optometrist working in a country region may be endorsed to issue a broader range of drugs when working in that country location, but not when practicing in the city.

CODE 01 to CODE 09

These codes apply to Psychologists (2723).

CODE 10 Conscious sedation

Dental practitioners (2523) may be endorsed for conscious sedation.

CODE 11 Rural and isolated practice

Registered nurses (2544) are permitted to supply scheduled medicines (rural and isolated practice).

Comments: This field is used to support searching for practitioners who can deliver services in a specific situation.

The requirement is based upon geography, organisation or equipment available which shall be met to permit the endorsement type to be actioned.
