Property:	Colorectal polyp type
Definition:	The type of colorectal polyp(s) found in an individual. A colorectal polyp is a small growth of colon tissue that protrudes into the colonic or rectal lumen. It is are usually asymptomatic, but sometimes it causes visible rectal bleeding, and, rarely, other symptoms.
Property group:	Illness and/or Injury event
