<b>Definition:</b>	<p>The overarching design of how maternity care is delivered to a woman or women.</p> <p>This is a multidimensional concept that incorporates attributes of the women being cared for, the type of healthcare providers who provide the care and how and where the care is provided.</p>
<b>Context:</b>	Used in maternal and perinatal healthcare settings.
<b>Specialisation of:</b>	<a href="#">Model of care</a>

<b>Definition:</b>	An indicator of whether an entity is a form of care whereby one midwife takes on the primary or lead care role throughout the pregnancy for an agreed number of women per year and acts as a second or "back-up" midwife for women who have another midwife as their primary carer.
