Property:	<a href="#">Adverse event indicator</a>
Definition:	<p>An indicator of whether there is an occurrence of an adverse event.</p> <p>An adverse event is any harmful event befalling a patient while in the care of the health system. Such an event may be the result of professional negligence, systems failure, mistakes, fatigue or other causes.</p>
Property group:	<a href="#">Illness and/or Injury event</a>
