

Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use:

The Children's Global Assessment Scale (CGAS) was developed to provide a measure of severity of disturbance in children and adolescents. It is designed to reflect the lowest level of functioning for a child or an adolescent during a specified period.

The measure provides a single global rating only, on a scale of 1 to 100. Clinicians assign a score, with 1 representing the most functionally impaired child, and 100 the healthiest child.

Scale ranges:

| 100- 91 | Superior functioning in all areas |
|------------|---|
| 90- 81 | Good functioning in all areas |
| 80- 71 | No more than slight impairments in functioning |
| 70- 61 | Some difficulty in a single area but generally functioning pretty well |
| 60- 51 | Variable functioning with sporadic difficulties or symptoms in several but not all social areas |
| 50- 41 | Moderate interference in functioning in most social areas or severe impairment of functioning in one area |
| 40- 31 | Major impairment of functioning in several areas and unable to function in one of these areas |
| 30- 21 | Unable to function in almost all areas |
| 20- 11 | Needs considerable supervision |
| 10-1 | Needs constant supervision |
