<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>CODE 1 Principal/director/coordinator/teacher in charge</p> <p>A person with overall responsibility for managing the service.</p> <p>CODE 2 Group leader/teacher</p> <p>A qualified early childhood teacher responsible for a group of young children.</p> <p>CODE 3 Assistant/aide</p> <p>An early childhood worker who helps a more senior and more qualified early childhood teacher.</p> <p>CODE 4 Other contact worker</p> <p>Includes people who provide child care or additional educational or supplementary services for children, such as a child care worker, dance teacher, music therapist, disability support worker, librarian or speech therapist.</p> <p>CODE 5 Non contact worker</p> <p>A worker who has no direct contact with children and primarily contributes to the running of the service or provides support services.</p>

### Collection and usage attributes

<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>This item is only applicable to paid workers in early childhood education and care services.</p> <p>For Codes 1 to 4 this <b>includes</b> <a href="#">contact workers</a> who are usually present to plan and deliver or support the delivery of a face-to-face early childhood education program, but may have been absent during the reference period due to illness or extended holiday leave and are expected to return.</p> <p>For Codes 1 to 4 this <b>excludes</b> relief teachers who are not present at the early childhood education and care service (i.e. not delivering a face-to-face early childhood education program) during the reference period.</p> <p><b>Delivery</b> (of an <a href="#">early childhood education program</a>) refers to face-to-face delivery of an early childhood education program or distance early childhood education program for at least one hour per week during the reference period by an early childhood education and care contact worker.</p>
<b>Collection methods:</b>	<p>Should be reported for the main role performed by a person during the reference period, regardless of whether this is different to their usual role.</p> <p>'Main' is defined as the role that the person spends the majority of time performing during the reference period.</p>
