No new data available for this cycle of reporting. Most recent data available is: 2010-2012 data released on 15 November 2013 and included in the 2012– 13 cycle of reporting. Life expectancy at birth estimates by Indigenous status for 2005-07 were revised based on improved measures of identification propensities.

Indigenous estimates of life expectancy are not produced for Victoria, South Australia, Tasmania or Australian Capital Territory due to the small number of Indigenous deaths reported in these jurisdictions.

Baseline year for NIRA target is 2006; baseline year for this indicator is 2005-2007; target year is 2031.
