Guide for use:

CODE 1 Debriefing

Debriefing is whereby the counsellor receives personal support in working through difficult cases.

CODE 2 Case consulting

Case consulting involves liaison with other workers in relation to care for the client.

Peer support is whereby support is provided by the counsellor's colleagues.
