Code 1 Major metropolitan hospitals

Metropolitan hospitals with >20,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations and >20,000 ED presentations per annum. AlHW A1 peer group >20,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations.

Excludes: Specialist women's and children's hospitals A2 AlHW peer group.

Code 2 Major regional hospitals

Regional hospitals with >16,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations and >20,000 ED presentations per annum. AlHW A1 peer group >16,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations.

Excludes: Specialist women's and children's hospitals A2 AlHW peer group.

Code 3 Large metropolitan hospitals

Metropolitan acute hospitals treating >10,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations and >20,000 ED presentations per annum. B1 and B2 AlHW peer group >10,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations.

Code 4 Large regional hospitals

Large regional acute hospitals treating >8,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations and >20,000 ED presentations per annum. All B1 and B2 AlHW peer group >8,000 acute casemix-adjusted separations.
